3. Surgery update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dr Rickwood will be on sick leave for 8 weeks following an operation in September • Dr Payne is leaving and will be replaced by Dr Rummonds. There are no changes to any of the nursing team. Primary care is coming together, and colleagues are working well together. The baseline income comes from the DOH and the rest goes to the PCN (primary care network) • There is a locality pharmacist lined up and the practice will fund 30% of his salary. • Eventually there will be paramedics and others working with practices and any money coming in can only be used for this purpose. • The flu campaign is already well organised. However, there has been a change of flu strain and so companies are late producing the vaccine for the under 65's. This means that under 65's cannot be vaccinated before Oct. The over 65's clinic will be on the 3rd Oct. This will be before the other vaccine arrives. Hopefully, 75% of patients will be vaccinated and this helps to stop the spread of flu.
