1. Introductions and welcome	Only 3 people present so not really quorate.
2. Minutes of last meeting	Taken as correct
3. Matters arising	Anne will look at name badges Large notice board completed The installation of the new phone system was delayed because of a problem with virgin cabling. It should now be in place. When Anita returns, we will ask which services can be signposted. We can then work on the next theme for the large board
4. Surgery update	Anita on sick leave at the moment but sent this information. A patient filled in a form suggesting that patients should be asked to solve key problems "power of the crowd". The main concern was " a lot of patients, myself included, worry about how on earth elderly or disabled or mentally incapacitated people ever get an appointment as they may not be able to queue up outside at 8am or be able to use the telephone. Could you put this dilemma to problem solving patients?" There are a few dates for meetings next year when Anita is not available. It may be necessary to change these.
